Dear Family in the Lord,

I'd like to follow up from my thoughts last week about using well summer opportunities to "rest in the Lord," reorder priorities, reclaim family and personal values that can easily get lost in the busyness, and actually experience renewal and refreshment through summer living. Hopefully, these renewed or newly-discovered patterns will carry into the fall and another busy season start up. It takes effort to stay balanced, to order priorities, and to grow in relationship with the "Lord and Giver of Life," as we put it, each time we profess our faith in the Nicene Creed at Holy Mass on Sunday.



Recently I came across these inspiring thoughts, placed as words on the lips of Jesus, present in the Most Blessed Sacrament. I share them with you as I, and I hope you too, seek to respond to them, to accept the invitation and promise they offer, and to experience real summer refreshment and renewal in my relationship with the Lord and my response to the vocation he has given me. I pray and wish this for you too!

"Adoration gives me the space in which to work in a soul. It is the great corrective for those who, by their personality and character, are in constant movement and ever restless. Be still and know that I am God! (Psalm 45:11). Open to Me the door of your heart and I will enter therein! (Revelation 3:20). There are those who go through life keeping me at a distance because they fear what I might do should they allow Me to come close to them. When you come before Me in adoration, hold yourself before My Eucharistic face like a mirror before the sun. Thus you will capture the radiance of My countenance and the fire that blazes in My heart; thus will you become both light and fire for souls plunged into darkness and hearts grown cold."

(In Sine Jesu, When Heart Speaks to Heart: A Journal of a Priest at Prayer)

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue

The National Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima is a beautiful hand-carved image of Our Lady of Fatima given to the United States by the bishop of Fatima after being blessed by Pope Paul VI in 1967. She was crowned by Cardinal O'Boyle at the National Basilica in Washington, DC in 1971.

This statue presently travels across the United States under the sponsorship of the WAF USA. She has proven time and again to be the catalyst for renewed interest in the message of Fatima and for exposing new generations of Catholics who are unaware of the important message of conversion and peace brought by Our Lady to the three shepherd children in 1917 at Fatima, Portugal.
